With the levels of staff churn there was and continues to be a huge demand for learning and training opportunities for new entrants and from existing staff who are due to move on.

This initiative was intended to complement existing knowledge management tools such as procedures manuals by aiming to capture the knowledge in an interesting way that is engaging and encourages learning.
